Definitions of synergy

noun, plural **syn-er-gies**

the interaction of elements that when combined produce a total effect that is greater than the sum of the individual elements, contributions, etc.

Syn-er-gy [sin-er-jee]

"the cooperative working together of two or more people or organizations, when their combined effect is greater than the sum of their individual efforts."



Synergistic effect



What is Synergistic effect?

Synergistic effects refer to the effects produced by the interaction that is greater than the sum of individual effects.

EXAMPLE: COOPERATION IS AN ECOLOGICAL SYNERGY AS EXHIBITED BY BEES IN A COLONY
